We focus on empowering individuals through:

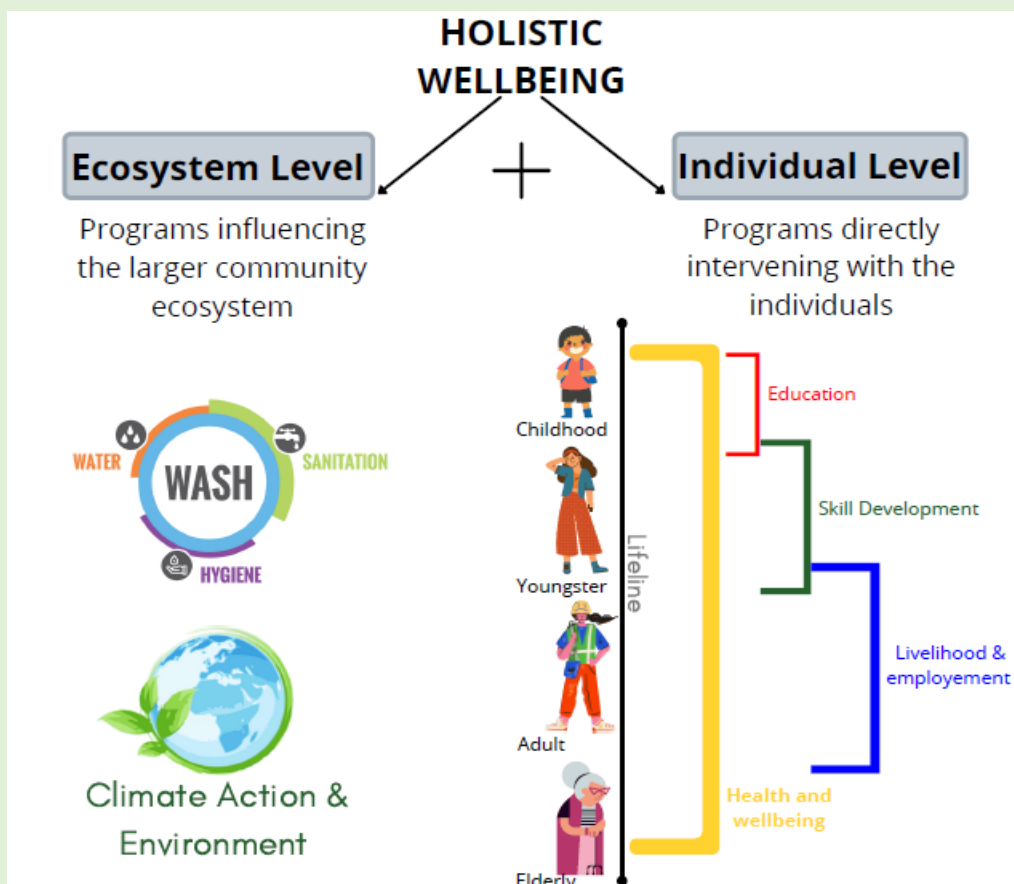
- **Health** – ensuring access to healthcare, awareness, and preventive measures.

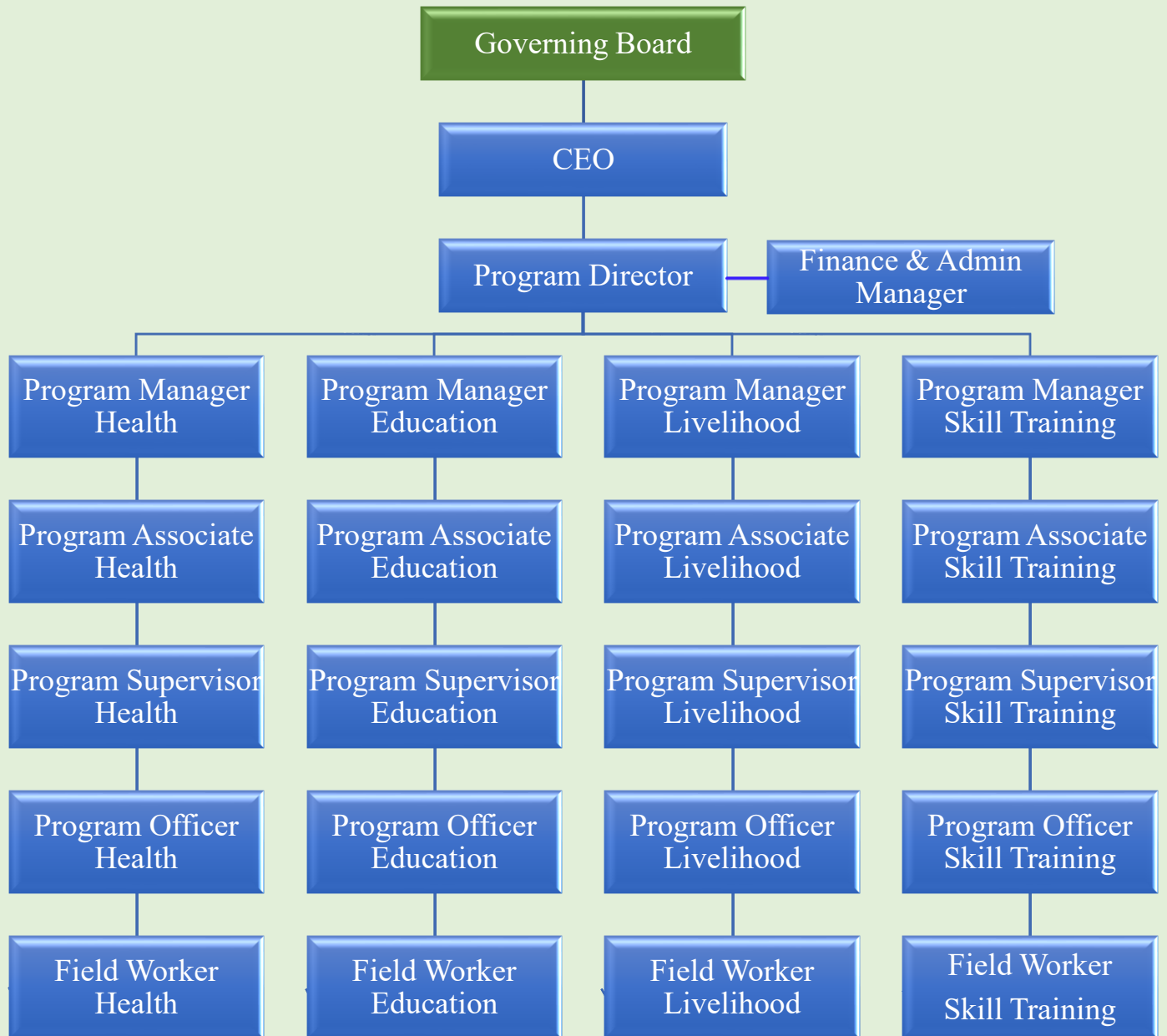
